SUH (Shelter for Urban Homeless)

- ❖ Who can be considered urban homeless?

Urban homeless individuals are those who do not have a home and instead live or sleep in places such as footpaths, parks, railway stations, bus stations, places of worship, outside shops and factories, construction sites, under bridges, inside large pipes, or any other open or uninhabitable places not suitable for human living.

Identification of Homeless People and Facilities Provided:
